Aim: Forming common legal framework within the sphere of sport relations.

Teachers of higher educational establishments, research workers, practicing lawyers, post-graduate students, and external doctorate students, 3rd-4th year students of Bachelor departments (first - cycle higher education) and students of Masters departments (second - cycle higher education) are invited to take part in the conference. Participation in the conference can be full-time or virtual.

Scientific and practical articles on the whole range of sport and legal, economic and management problems in sports can be submitted for publication. Undergraduate Bachelor students' (3rd - 4th years of studying) (first - cycle higher education) articles are accepted in co-authorship with their scientific supervisors.

Guidelines of the conference:

1. National and international sports legislation.
2. Professional sport.
3. Sport law and order issues
4. Legal responsibility in sports; sports disputes resolution.
5. Anti-doping regulation issues.
6. Agency in sport.
7. Legal regulation of sports (Olympic, Paralympic, Deaflympic, etc.).

Article submission guidelines.

Working languages: Russian, English. Short annotation (up to 300 typographical units with spaces), key words (no more than five) in Russian and in English. Article length: 5–10 pages. Article text must be presented in file form A 4 size (in Ms Word format), Times New Roman 14 print, 1,5 line spacing; new paragraph – 1, 25 sm.; margins: upper, lower, – 20 mm, left – 30 mm, right - 10 mm,; text alignment – breadth-wise; without page numbering. References must be put at the end of the article (in articles presented in square brackets) notes. A recommended sample of articles submission is presented in Appendix 1.

Articles with applications are accepted up to **4th of April, 2021** included, by e-mails: sportpravouralgufk@yandex.ru (marked «Conference») («Конференция»). Application form is presented in Appendix 2.

Summarizing the conference results, a collection of research papers from the conference will be published, and presented at the site of the Federal State Budgetary Educational Establishment of High Education «UralSUPC» in electronic form, it will be included into Russian Science Citation Index (RSCI) and sent to authors. The articles collection in printed form will be sent at the request of the author, the shipment will be at the expense of the author.
